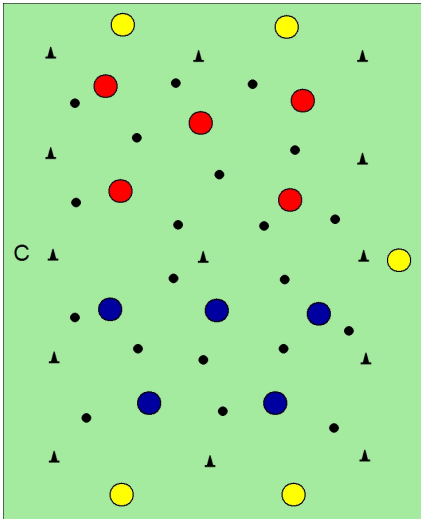




Bombs away



How it works

Two teams start inside next door squares with lots of balls (bombs) spread around.

A third team stands around the outside of the two squares.

On a signal from the coach the players try to pass as many balls as they can into the other team's square.

The yellow team and the coach can pass back in any balls that come out of the playing area.

Play for 1 minute then stop and count up the number of balls (bombs) in each square to work out the winning team.

Yellow team swaps with one of the other teams and play again.

Then repeat so each team has played against each other.

Possible changes

If you have a large group you can play this game in four squares with players allowed to pass the ball into any other team's square (look to see which team has the fewest).

Again it helps to have players around the outside to pass balls back in. This version of the game works especially well indoors.
