

Respect Codes of Conduct

Players

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why the T.S.A. is asking every player to follow a **Respect Code of Conduct**.

When playing soccer I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability
- · Play fairly- I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- · Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and the coaching staff
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- Shake hands with the other team, and referee at the the end of the game, without dissent.
- · Listen and respond to what the coaching staff tell me

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, or the T.S.A.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, match officials or coaching staff
- · Receive a formal warning from the coach, club or T.S.A.
- · Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- · Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- \cdot $\,$ My club, or the T.S.A. may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- · I can bring forward my concerns about others behaviour using the "Respect Report" Process (outlined below)
